Universidad Católica de Valencia (UCV), member of the EU-CONEXUS European University, is pleased to announce the first EU-CONEXUS International Staff Training Week.

<u>Universidad Católica de Valencia</u> is a private university in Spain founded in 2003, and today it has more than 11,000 students and 1,300 staff. The academic offer for students consists of 84 Bachelor's, Master's and Ph.D. study programmes ranging from experimental, health to social sciences, sports and education. Integrated education, applied at the University, involves professional and personal growth of each student, strong focus on employability and social responsibility.

International collaborations and partnerships cover nearly 60 countries based on around 350 bilateral agreements, more than 10 international networks and associations and several European projects. One of the main goals and activities of the EU-CONEXUS consortium is the development of joint study offers at Bachelor's, Master's and Ph.D. cycle as well as courses for schools, vocational training centres and companies, with a special emphasis on innovative teaching approaches and methodologies, student-centred learning and teaching, digital classroom and virtual exchanges and mobilities.
