

History

Zadar has a centuries-old university tradition: In 1396 the Dominican general institution of higher education, called *Universitas ladertina*, was founded in Zadar as the first institution of higher education in Croatia

In 1956, the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Zadar was founded, at first as part of the University of Zagreb, and later as part of the University of Split;

The University of Zadar was established in 2002 with 16 Departments, 17 different study BA and MA programmes and six doctoral study programmes.



University today

University of Zadar is the largest entirely integrated University in Croatia consisting of 27 Departments.

Most of the departments offer study programmes in humanities and social sciences, but several departments offer study programmes also in technical, bio-technical, health studies and biomedical science, as well as one interdisciplinary study programme (Geography).



A total of 189 courses are offered divided into three categories: foreign language for specific purposes (LSP), foreign language for beginners, and translation exercises in five proficiency levels (from A1 to C1 according to CEFR).

Courses are offered in nine different languages: English, French, Croatian, Japanese, Chinese, German, Russian, Spanish, and Italian.









Research profile (Scopus)




