[Much more than a Market: Speed, Security, Solidarity](#): Empowering the Single Market to deliver a sustainable future and prosperity for all Citizens by Enrico Letta: The former Italian prime minister and current president of the Jacques Delors Institute (France) requests in this report to add a 5th freedom for a new single market to the four existing ones that should enhance research, innovation and education. European universities alliances are explicitly mentioned as central for promoting learning and labour mobility necessary "to fill skills and labour market gaps and leverage all its opportunities".

July 2024

[Political Guidelines for the Next European Commission](#) by Ursula von der Leyen: Inaugurating her second mandate the President of the European Commission issued political guidelines for the following 5 years. She mentions the European universities alliances on page 11: "It also means attracting new talents and retaining the best and brightest minds here in Europe. To do this, I want to strengthen the collaboration between research departments, higher education and business – notably by strengthening our University Alliances."

[The Future of European Competitiveness by Mario Draghi](#): The former Italian prime minister submitted a study commissioned by EU Commission President Ursula von der Leyen on European competitiveness. The report contributes to the discussions about the next multi-annual financial framework (2028-2035) and highlights the role of universities and research and innovation in addressing an increasing skills gap and a lack of innovations.
