


The city of Valencia



Recommendations on how to arrive to Valencia City from Valencia Airport



 Taxi: there's a taxi stop at the airport, 0 floor (arrivals). Price 30€, night fare is higher. • Taxi apps







 Underground (metro) and tram: the subway station is inside the airport,-1 floor Price: 4.80€ (ABC zone) and you will get a rechargeable card.

TIP: Buy SUMA 10 Card

It is a 10-journey pass, valid on buses, MetroBus, the underground and trams. You can change between different lines or types of transport, as long as it is within 90 minutes.

Zone A: for travel within the city.

Zone C: required for journeys to or from the

airport.

Where to buy SUMA 10?

To be able to load these travel passes, you will need to purchase a Móbilis card, either plastic (2€) or cardboard (1€). These can be bought from machines located at Metrovalencia stations including the airport), kiosks and tobacco shops.
