




### Instructions on how to apply for Micro-credentials in Smart Urban Coastal Sustainability

If:

- you meet the programme's requirements you are a Bachelor student in one of the 9 partner universities of EU-CONEXUS and your English is on B2 level,
- you have already chosen the micro-credentials that you would like to participate in (available on EU-CONEXUS website),
- you have consulted the timetables of the classes (available at the website of each micro-credential separately),
- you have read the rules of the programme, <u>Guidelines for students</u>,

you are ready to apply! 😊


- Enter the EU-CONEXUS application platform
- Choose the application period that is currently available:








The application form will be displayed. Please fill it in, carefully reading the instructions. The form has 9 sections and all of them need to be filled in before submitting.




You can save the draft of the application at any stage:








5 Choosing the Programme and creating your own studyplan:




To be able to choose the micro-credentials you want to participate in, you need to complete your study plan. After clicking on "My study plan", you get redirected to the website where you can choose the micro-credentials from the dropdown list:








Once you click on the arrow on the dropdown list, a list of the micro-credentials gets displayed. They are all visible once you scroll up and down.




Each time you click on the chosen micro-credential, it gets added to your study plan.



You can add and delete the micro-credentials to your study plan until you submit your application. You can choose minimum 1 micro-credential and maximum 3 of them per each semester.


Once you finish choosing the micro-credentials you need to save your study plan on the upper part of the same website (without coming back):








After coming back to the application form, you continue filling in the information about yourself:

In the task "MCs Proof of English language proficiency, there are 4 options and one to be chosen out of them:

#### MCs Proof of English language proficiency To be eligible, you need to have English level Please choose one of the options below to best reflect your preference or current situation. Please attach relevant proof of your English language proficiency. If you want to attached I have NOT uploaded language certificate yet more than one file, please merge them together into one PDF. I am SETU/WIT student with English as my first language. I am uploading my ID/passport/driving licence (one of them). If you do not have any certificate or proof of Engish, please check your level by completing I am attaching my English certificate - sufficient proof of min. 
<u>If you choose the 1st option: "I have NOT uploadad language certificate yet"</u>, your application will be put on hold. Remember to save the draft, so that the application is prepared for when you are ready to continue with it. The system will send you reminders to complete this task every 3 days.

If you choose the 2<sup>nd</sup> option: "I am SETU/WIT student with English as my first language. I am uploading my ID/passport/driving licence (one of them)", being a student of South East Technological University or Waterford Institute of Technology in Ireland, and English native speaker, you just need to upload a photo/scan of your ID, passport or driving licence. No need for English level proof here. This refers only to students with English as the first language. If you are a foreign student studying at SETU/WIT, you are still required to upload a certificate or take a test.






If you scroll down, below of the text, on the right-hand side, you can find a box that allows you to submit the document:



If you choose the 3<sup>rd</sup> option: "I am attaching my English certificate – sufficient proof of min. B2 level", you should upload an official certificate that demonstrates your level of English (B2 is the minimum English level required for this programme). It can be any official certificate (IELTS, TOEFL, CEFR, Cambridge or equivalent) or exam you have taken at your university.


If you scroll down, below of the text, on the right-hand side, you can find a box that allows you to submit the certificate:



If you choose the 4<sup>th</sup> option: "I have completed online English Placement Test and I am attaching the certificate", you need to click in the link indicated in the application, log in/register using EU login:




Then, choose "Start assessment":









Once you finish the test, you will be able to download the pdf with the result of the test:



Coming back to the application form where you left it: if you scroll down, below of the text, on the right-hand side, you can find the window that allows you to submit the certificate:




Correctly updated document should be displayed like this:








When it comes to the second task, "MCs personal data revision":

Correctly completed Checklist should be displayed like this:








Once your application is completed, you need to submit it:





If there are some mistakes in the application, the platform will let you know about it:
