# POLITICAL ENVIRONMENT AND REGULATORY FRAMEWORK FOR ALLIANCES

#### **July 2025**

Council Resolution on a joint European degree label and the next steps towards a possible joint European degree: boosting Europe's competitiveness and the attractiveness of European higher education:

The Council's resolution sets out the member states' vision for a joint European degree label and proposes a roadmap towards a possible joint European degree, with three phases to be carried out by 2029. The accompanying recommendation specifies the criteria for awarding the joint European degree label. The label would be granted to joint programmes delivered via transnational cooperation between universities from different countries, including at least two EU member states. ## Towards a Stronger Europe: Franco-German-Irish Perspectives on the Future of European University Alliances

Fourteen alliances are active in Irish academic institutions, and all were present including EU-CONEXUS. The conference also provided a forum to discuss common challenges and share best practice ahead of next year's Irish Presidency of the European Union.
