Due to very low response rate (7.59%), it is not possible to give any suggestions nor recommendations regarding Teaching Staff survey.

Very high average score might arise from very high motivation of teachers who completed the study. However, no information is available about remaining 92% of teachers. It is not known whether they are (dis)satisfied with JMPMB and what the reasons might be for their (dis)satisfaction.
